# III. Opening Remarks by Mayor

- A. Mayor Bruggeman welcomed all in attendance and reminded everyone that the last council meeting held on January 22, 2018 had an agenda item related to the development and location of a new water intake structure at Lake Wright Patman. Council had questions and Mr. Mayo was not in attendance at that council meeting. Council decided to postpone the vote on that agenda item and host this workshop to gain additional insight.
- B. Mr. Mayo said he had additional information to share with the city attorney and city council and therefor asked for a closed session.

### A. Discussion on the History of Riverbend

Kelly Mitchell provided information on existing regional water infrastructure and capacity issues.

# B. Discussion on Water Intake Structure at Lake Wright Patman

Liz Fazio Hale and Steve Mayo provided the following information: Riverbend is a good choice to facilitate the intake structure project overall. While water rates remain low for citizens, infrastructure is aging rapidly so there is much work to be done. It is vitally important to keep the process moving forward in order to meet the growing region's future water needs. Riverbend has been working diligently to represent the city's interests and asked the council for its support.

Texarkana City Council response in Summary: There is a need for solid understanding before casting a vote on a matter that will affect Texarkana for the next several decades. New council members should be fully informed in order to understand why the joint resolution is before the council. The council has a huge responsibility and accountability to its citizens. The council shares the mission of Riverbend ad is willing to work together. The council thanked Riverbend for its patience, enduring work and service on its behalf.

Steve Mayo gave his assurance to facilitate better future communications. It is important that new council members are comfortable with their decision making. The city Council and Riverbend are on the same team and each want the process to be done right.
