Jack Salmon led the invocation.

III. Public Comment

Public comments were invited at the end of the agenda under item V.

IV. Joint Meeting Agenda

A. Updates Regarding Projects in the Sulphur River Basin

Discussion of the current state of Water Planning Activities in Sulphur river Basin, including:

1. Sulphur River Basin Authority (SRBA)

Chris Spencer provided information on the Texas Sunset legislation passed in 2017 and the role of the SRBA as a basin quality management entity.

Bret McCoy and Kelly Mitchell provided information on the reallocation of Wright Patman Lake as well as a mitigation workshop they attended in Ft. Worth, Texas. Bret McCoy emphasized that Marvin Nichols was not part of the ongoing Corps' Reallocation Study at Wright Patman Lake.

2. City of Texarkana, Texas

Steve Mayo provided information on working with the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) since 2016 on storage fees, cultural research studies and locations of Indian burial grounds, as well as the implementation of the Ultimate Rule Curve (URC). This is a constant source of frustration due to the lack of progress with its implementation.

3. Riverbend Water Resources District (RWRD)

Liz Fazio Hale provided information on current studies that are being completed by RWRD. One is an update to the Water Availability Model. The last model that was completed was in the late 1990s. Robert J. Brandes conducted the previous study and is also completing the updated study. Another study that is being conducted by Arroyo Environmental and LJA Consultants and LJA Engineering, that began in July 2018, is a Volumetric and Sedimentation Study on Wright Patman Lake. Completion of both of these studies is expected by December 2018.

B. Collaboration on moving forward in the Sulphur River Basin, communications with one another, and ways to combine efforts.

Steve Mayo asked how the City of Texarkana and Riverbend could have more participation in the on-going efforts of SRBA. He also asked about RWRD being formally involved in a reallocation study.

Chris Spencer suggested that all parties stay transparent and keep the needs of all citizens of the region at the forefront, adding that SRBA intended more communications. Another suggestion was that representatives from each entity attend the meetings of the other entities.

Steve Mayo emphasized that it's more than just communication, it is formal, meaningful representation at the table.

Kelly Mitchell informed us that while SRBA will remain transparent, some of the meetings they have with the USACE are not officially open meetings and therefore are not open to the public. Mr. Mitchell also brought up funding for the SRBA. They have a need for a bigger budget. Currently, the SRBA is funded by the Dallas-Ft. Worth metroplex which is outside of the river basin. Bret McCoy stated that the funding from the metroplex is a cause for citizens within the basin to distrust the SRBA.

V. Public Comments

James Carlow, Bowie County Judge stated how proud he is to see the SRBA, RWRD, and the City of Texarkana, Texas working together for the betterment of the region for the first time.

David Nabors, Paris, Texas wants to see the entities continue to work together to protect our basin from outside forces

Gary Van Deaver reinforced Judge Carlow's sentiments on keeping the lines of communication open between the entities, as well as with the elected officials.

Curtis Hairston, Maud, Texas expressed a desire to incorporate wildlife easements as opposed to taking land for mitigation.

Nancy Clements, Cass County, Texas stated that she has been fighting for our region along-side Ward Timber and other landowners against SRBA for many years. She is very glad that RWRD is involved as a local representative.
