# A. Discussion and possible action regarding a Texas legislative update with Representative Gary Van Deaver

Representative Van Deaver provided an update on the current legislative session. The budget has passed in the House and is now up for consideration in the Senate.

He informed the board that House Bill 1574 regarding the sit-out provision for the Board of Directors of Riverbend as well as the inclusion of water supply corporations becoming members of Riverbend, is on the calendar for a vote and he does not see any reason why it would not pass.

Marshall Wood thanked Representative Van Deaver for taking the time to meet with him and Sonja Hubbard. Mr. Wood was appreciative of the communication with the Board and for hearing their concerns.

Fred Milton expressed his appreciation for cooperation in going forward with water rights applications, bond issuance, and other items as they arise.

# B. Discussion and possible action regarding a resolution amending the Riverbend Water Resources District Bylaws concerning District Audits.

Tara Houck, Senior Accountant, read the Riverbend Bylaws. Specifically, the change to Article 12-Uniform Financial Reporting.

Under the current contract an increase in salary to \$225,000 annually, effective March 28, 2019 through April 26, 2019. Beginning April 27, 2019 through June 15, 2019, Riverbend would employ Mrs. Fazio Hale as an independent contractor based upon her salary on the date of separation of employment plus compensation in kind for any benefits to which she would have been entitled under her current contract during the period in which she is employed as an independent contractor.

The motion passed unanimously.
